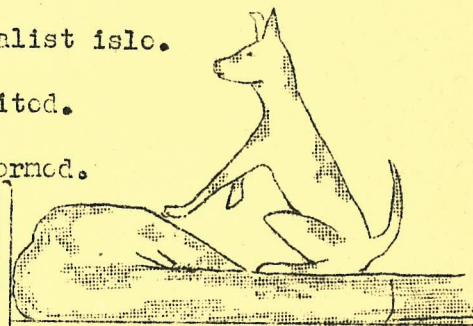

Milwaukee turns back Phillies 3 - 2

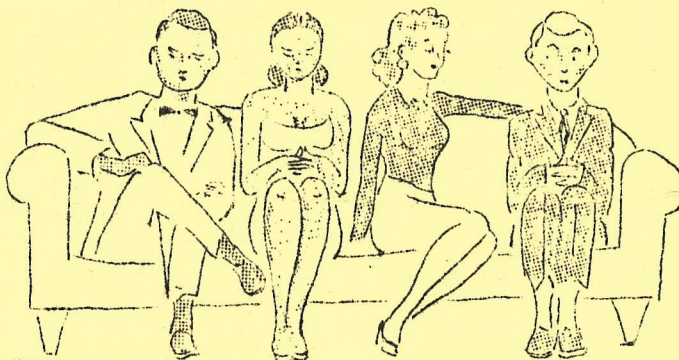
